Handicamp

Handicamp is a unique Rotary program. Each year, up to 24 people aged from 18 to around 38 years old with mild to moderate intellectual or physical challenges are selected to take part in the week-long camp.

They enjoy fun and fellowship, grow through new experiences and involve themselves in a range of activities they might normally miss.

At the same time, Handicamp provides respite for their carers, most of whom are parents or other family members.

Each camper is matched with a full-time volunteer carer for the week. The carers, with support from the camp coordinator, nurse and other experienced carers, have the task of ensuring the welfare of their campers and do everything in their power to see they have a great experience.

Rotary clubs nominate and sponsor the attendance of campers and volunteer carers to attend Handicamp. The entire cost of Handicamp is funded by Rotary clubs. It costs about \$395 to send each camper and carer to Handicamp.

Handicamp is usually held in April. Nominations of campers and carers should be submitted to your local Rotary club by February-March.

The campers and voluntary carers form close bonds of friendship at Handicamp
