Rotary Youth Leadership Award



The Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) offers young men and women the opportunity to develop their leadership skills at a five-day residential training seminar.

Participants take part in activities such as abseiling, rock climbing, hiking, presentation skills, conflict resolution and discussions on social issues.

RYLA provides a rare opportunity to learn, grow, have fun and make new friends.

Candidates for RYLA are aged between 18 and 25. They may be male or female, students or in the workforce; most importantly, they must have leadership qualities and the talent, energy and motivation to discover their potential.

The RYLA seminar is held in late January-early February each year. Nominations for selection for RYLA can be made to any local Rotary club by November.

Attendance fees for the selected RYLA participants are paid by the nominating Rotary club – participants are generally asked to contribute no more than \$50 towards camp expenses.
