### Siemens Science Experience

The Siemens Science Experience is a national activity established, managed and conducted by the Science Schools Foundation Inc, an independent non-profit association of educationists, Rotarians and industrialists.

For students who are in Year 9 (and heading to Year 10) and have an interest in science, the Siemens Science Experience is a fun three days of activities in participating universities and tertiary institutions.

In laboratories and lecture theatres, the students perform experiments, meet and hear senior lecturers, make site visits and experience the intellectual excitement of being on campus.

They learn about opportunities to progress their studies in science, technology and engineering as well as future career possibilities.

One of the most enduring memories of the more than 40,000 students who have taken part in the Siemens Science Experience is the the opportunity to meet and share ideas with students from different schools, and recognise that many others share their interest in and fascination with science.

Any Year 9 student about to enter Year 10 is able to apply for the Siemens Science Experience through a local Rotary club.
