National Youth Science Forum

The National Youth Science Forum is a 12-day program for students who are thinking about a career in science, engineering or technology. The fully residential program is hosted in January each year by the Australian National University in Canberra.

Students are introduced to research and researchers, encouraging excellence in all their undertakings and helping them to develop their communication and interpersonal skills.

The NYSF places equal emphasis on pure research, applied research and engineering in the physical and biological sciences.

All activities are fully supervised by student staff and resident Rotary counsellors. Following the residential forum, participants can take part in university seminars and industry site visits.

As well as the immediate activities, NYSF students gain a network of friends, colleagues and support groups throughout Australia that will assist participants for the whole of their lives.

Students may nominate for NYSF through their local Rotary club during Year 11. The deadline for nominations is usually in mid-May, with an interview process leading to the naming of the participants in September.

The cost of NYSF attendance is \$1830. The nominating Rotary club may assist a selected participant by contributing a portion of the cost.
